Today we have gathered here to be the part of 43rd Annual Day Celebrations of our School. Lord Poornathrayeesa and Goddess Bhuvaneshwary, the ruling deities of Thripunithura have showered their blessings on us, through these years. Pranams at their feet. We remember with reverence the great visionary and founder of Nair Service Society, the late Bharat Kesari Sri. Mannathu Padmanabhan. Our tribute also goes to late Kalathil Velayudhan Nair, the Patron of NSS School, Tripunithura.

Our School, located in the centre of this heritage town holds firmly the Indian values and culture. It started functioning in 1975 with the aim of imparting quality education to the ordinary folk of the society. Being the first CBSE School in this area we still hold the quality and reputation amongst all.

The annual plan for 2017-18 was prepared during the month of May 2017. A 4 day intensive training programme was conducted for the entire teaching staff. A comprehensive calendar of activities was prepared in that training session and planned all activities for the academic year 2017-18. The main focus of the training included Empowerment of Teachers, Effective classroom management, Evaluation strategies, Preparation of lesson plan etc.

The X and XII results were announced in May and we secured 100% result both in AISSE and AISSCE 2017 . 53 students appeared for the AISSCE examination, S Atchaya scored A1 in all subjects. The toppers were:

In Class X, 92 students appeared for the exam and 21 students secured A1 in all subjects.

The World Environment Day, Reading Day Yoga Day, The Day Against Drug Abuse, Ozone Day, Children's Day, World Aids Day, Keralapiravi Day, Teachers Day etc were all celebrated in a full fledged way giving due reverence and significance for the occasion. Minor Skits, Dances and demonstrations along with campaigns and rallies were organised on theme basis to convey the message of these days.

National festivals like Independence Day and Republic Day were celebrated by the students by taking part in March Past followed by Quiz, Drawing and Essay writing competitions.

We observe Ramayana Month earnestly every year. After the school level, the final round at Chenganassery is also being held. Our school secured the 'All Rounder' title this year also. The festivals of Onam and Christmas are celebrated in the campus with pomp and show. In both cases the seasonal game were held for the enthusiastic children. Gandhi Jayanthi was remarkable by the cleaning of our entire campus and thus the children learning the value of service.

The school wise cultural competitions were conducted in July. This year we were blessed with a special guest on the day - Sri Sabareesh Prabhakar - the well known young violinist who is our former student. The students were enthralled by his performance.

All the students from LKG to STD XII are taken for study trips to various destinations in order to give them exposure and for enhancement of knowledge.

In our school the various clubs are having the responsibility in the celebration and observation of all important days and events.

The teachers too received great exposure from a number of Orientation Programmes and Workshops. Counselling programmes were compiled for students of Class X and XII.
